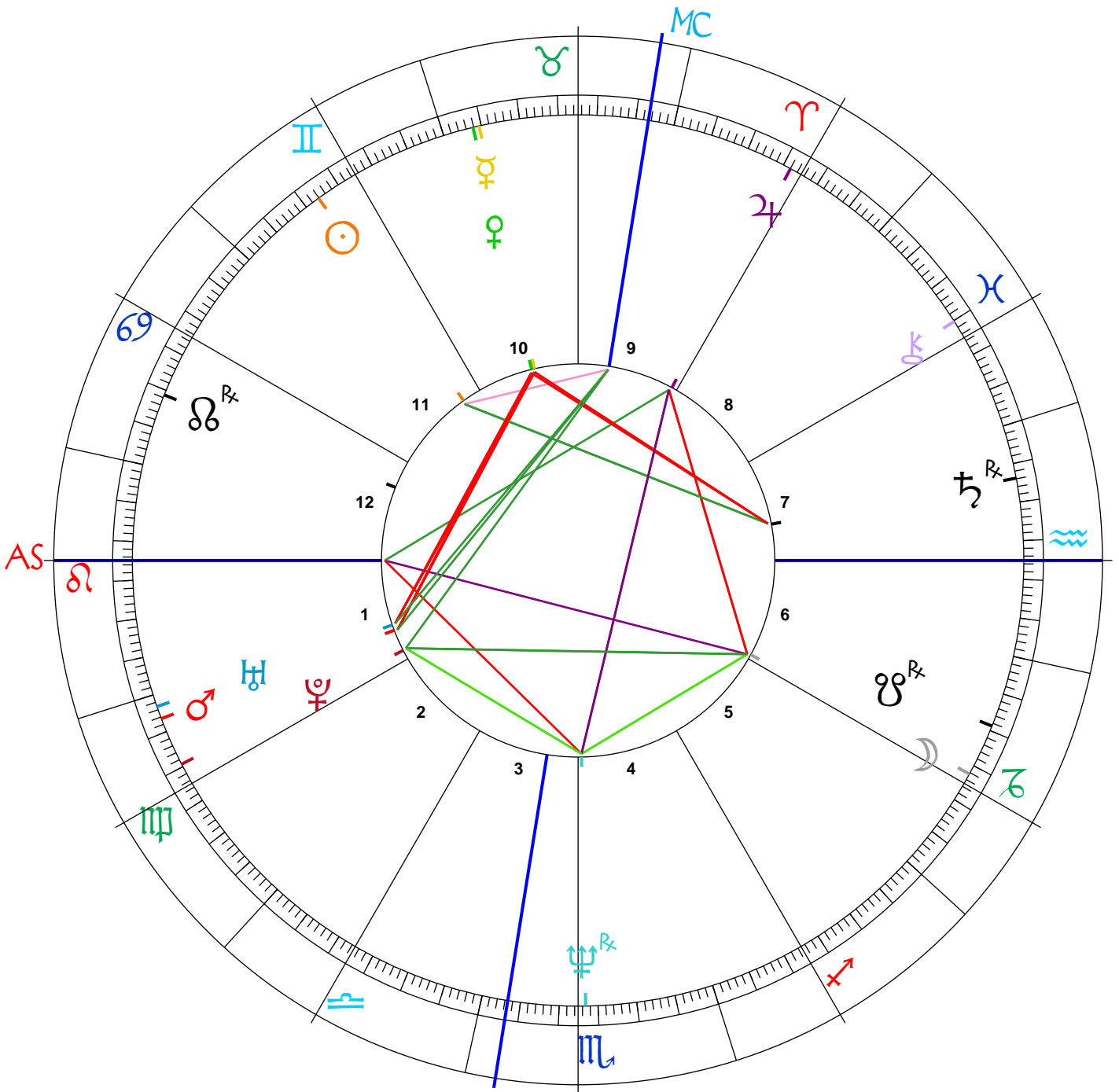

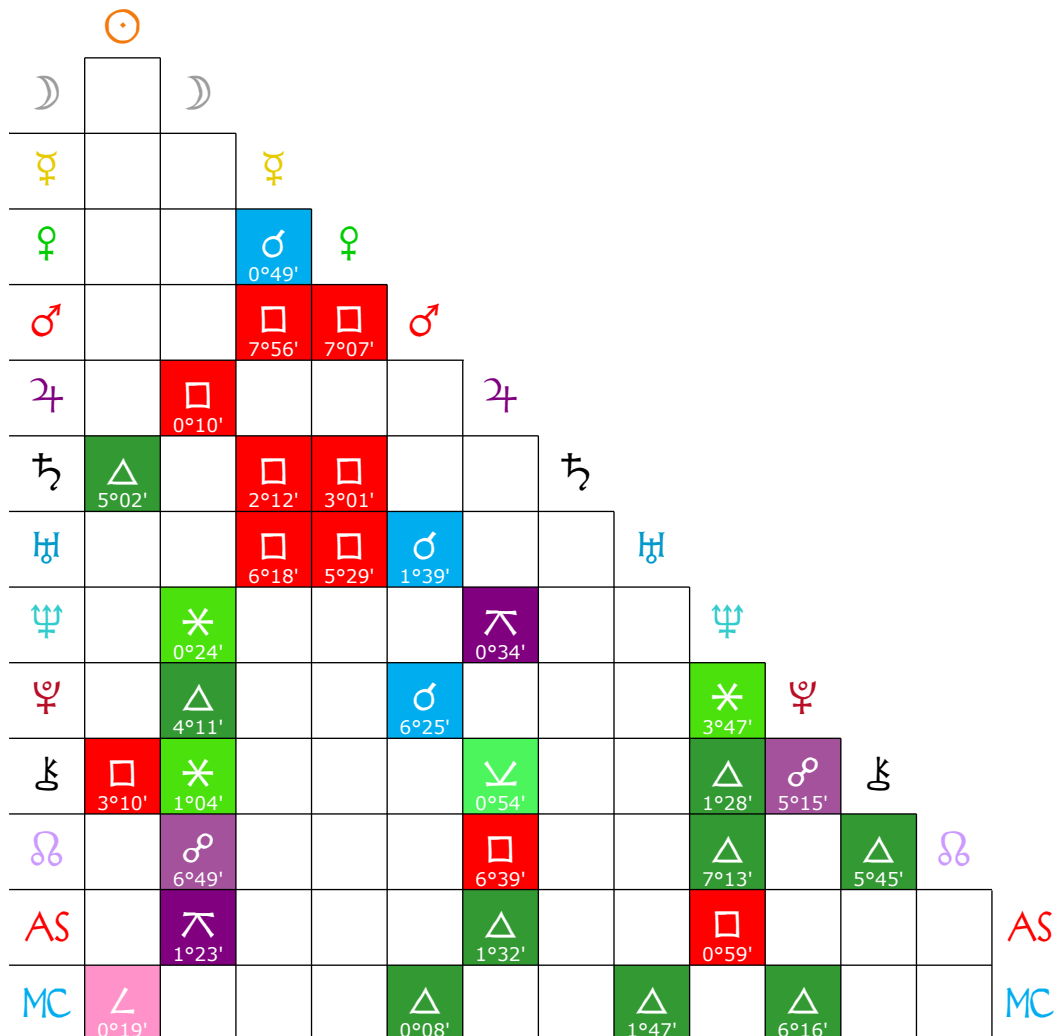

What Is Astrology?

The basic philosophy behind Astrology is the idea that we live in a holistic universe, that there is a deep interrelationship between the whole and its parts, and that anything, be it an event, a group, or an individual that is born at a particular point in time and space in a sense embodies the whole universe focused at that point.

Obviously it is impossible to determine the state of the whole universe from a particular point in time and space, so in Astrology we take the Solar system as the greater whole and regard the patterns formed by the Sun, Moon and planets as seen from a particular time and place on earth as a reflection of the forces acting at that time and place.

In natal astrology, astrology applied to individual human beings, the Sun, Moon and planets symbolise basic human needs, desires or urges which we all possess. It is the ever changing interrelationship between these basic functions or archetypes, and their relationship to the horizon at the time of birth, that are used to symbolise the personality structure of a human being.

Your Life Destiny Report details the following:

Elements

Each of the twelve signs is assigned to one of the four Elements: Earth, Air, Fire and Water. Each planet together with the Ascendant and Midheaven according to its sign therefore has an elemental quality.

Modality

Each of the twelve signs is assigned to one of three Modalities: Cardinal, Mutable and Fixed. Each planet together with the Ascendant and Midheaven according to its sign therefore has a specific quality or mode of operation.

The Planets

The Sun, Moon and the planets: - Mercury, Venus, Mars, Jupiter, Saturn, Uranus, Neptune and Pluto, represent specific functions, drives, or urges within the total personality. Just as in the body the various organs; heart, kidneys, liver etc. perform their own specific functions yet operate as part of a total system; so the planets can be regarded as symbolising the 'organs' of your total personality.

The Outer Planets

The planets beyond Saturn: - Uranus, Neptune and Pluto, move through the signs so slowly that the sign positions of these planets refer more to the generation of which we are a part, rather than individual characteristics.

It is the house position that shows where we will meet with the principles expressed by these planets in our lives. The aspects of these planets to the personal planets show how we get on with the principles they represent.

These trans-Saturnian planets cannot be seen without the aid of a telescope. Therefore they represent powerful forces that are beyond conscious control. These planets connect us with forces and levels of reality beyond our experience as individual human beings. They do this by breaking down the boundaries of the ego (symbolised by Saturn), to allow the inflow of higher ideals and goals into our ego-centred minds. This can often mean the total disruption or destruction of the outer and inner structures of our lives in order to make this possible.

Aspects

A conjunction is where two planets are at the same place, and their energies are merged together. Trines (when two planets are 120 degrees apart), and sextiles (60 degrees), between two planets indicate an easy flow of energy between the functions involved, they therefore show aspects of your personality that work harmoniously together indicating inherent abilities or talents.

Squares (when two planets are 90 degrees apart) and oppositions (when two planets are 180 degrees apart) show that there is some stress or tension between the two functions involved. Squares and oppositions between planets therefore indicate inner conflicts and tensions (conscious or unconscious) that throughout your life you will be forced to recognise and express in a positive way.

If you are not conscious of these inner conflicts, they will be confronted through seemingly 'fated' external events or in relationships with others, particularly when the planets involved are activated by transits (detailed in your forecast).

A tolerance or "orb" of about 8 degrees is allowed either side of the exact aspect, but the wider the orb, the weaker the influence. To the right of each pair of 'aspect' symbols is a group of five stars ★☆☆☆☆, the more dark stars there are the more important the connection.

There are also two sets of minor aspects. They have a smaller orb of influence, and their effects are not so noticeable. These include the semi-sextiles (when two planets are 30 degrees apart) and the quinquax (when they are 150 degrees apart). These minor aspects indicate energy patterns that are not well integrated into the individual's character. They exist, and of course, must be accommodated somehow.

The other series includes the semi-square (when two planets are 45 degrees apart) the sesquiquadrate (when two planets are 135 degrees apart). These minor aspects are quite similar to the square, only not quite as potent. They represent energy patterns that must be acted upon by the individual and, when properly used and understood, can bring about benefits in self-understanding.

This is not to say that trines and sextiles are "good" and squares and oppositions are "bad".

A chart dominated by flowing aspects may indicate someone for whom everything comes too easily, they will therefore lack any real motivation and may not achieve much during their life.

A chart with many stressful aspects, on the other hand, may indicate someone who driven by his or her own inner conflicts, can achieve something of real worth in their lives. The stressful aspects are just as necessary to us as the flowing aspects, and most of us are a fairly even balance of both.

The activity of each planet is further modified by the sign in which it is placed, the effects of these modifications in your particular case will be described in the chart analysis.

When astrologers cast horoscopes, it is important that the precise time of birth be used because it helps to determine the correct orientation of the houses of the chart. The position of the planets within the twelve houses, indicate which of these twelve areas of life concerns are most important for you.

Should a house have no planets, this does not mean that the affairs of the house are not important. It merely means that those affairs are probably well integrated and are not therefore major issues for you. But when a house has a planet or several planets, it indicates that the issues of the house are more significant.

The Signs

During the course of a year the Sun, as seen from the earth, appears to move in a circle against the background of the stars, this circle is known as the ecliptic. The axis of the earth's rotation is inclined at an angle to the plane of the ecliptic, so, if the earth's equator is imagined to be extended into space, it cuts the plane of the ecliptic at two points known as the equinoxes.

One of these points, the vernal or spring equinox, is taken to be the beginning of the circle and is known, both in Astronomy and Astrology, as the first point of Aries. Astrologers then divide the ecliptic into twelve sections of 30 degrees each thus generating the twelve signs. The autumn equinox is directly opposite the first point of Aries and is the beginning of the sign of Libra. When the Sun is at these points, days and nights are of equal length.

During the summer months the Sun appears to rise higher and higher in the sky, reaching its highest point at midsummer or the summer solstice, the beginning of the sign of Cancer. This is the time of the longest day and shortest night. Similarly, it reaches its lowest point in the sky in midwinter or the winter solstice, the beginning of the sign of Capricorn. This is the time of the shortest day and longest night.

The signs of zodiac therefore, has nothing to do with actual star constellations, but is based on the relationship between Sun and Earth.

The Houses (ignore when time of birth not known)

You will see that the chart is divided into twelve sections. These represent the division of the space surrounding you at birth. The sign on the first house "cusp" (the line that marks the beginning of the house) is the sign that was rising over the horizon at the time and place of your birth this is your rising sign, (or Ascendant). The sign on the seventh house cusp is the sign that was setting at the time of your birth, the line between the first and 7th house cusps therefore represents the horizon.

Planets in the upper hemisphere were therefore above the horizon at the time of birth, and planets in the lower hemisphere were below the horizon; planets in the left hemisphere (left of the line joining the 0th and 4th house cusps) were rising in the east and planets in the right hemisphere were setting in the west.

Each house represents a specific area of life experience. The positions of the planets in these houses therefore show in what areas of experience the effects of these planets will be most noticeable. The Ascendant is an important point and has its own particular meaning.

The Birth Chart

The birth chart is a symbolic map of the solar system as seen from the earth at the time and place of birth. The chart is comprised of three basic factors.

- (1) The aspects (angles) formed between the Sun, Moon and planets, as seen from the earth. These are indicated by the lines on a birth chart.
- (2) Each planet is located in a particular sign of the zodiac. The symbols for each sign are placed around the edge of the chart, Aries, Taurus, Gemini, Cancer, Leo, Virgo, Libra, Scorpio, Sagittarius, Capricorn, Aquarius, and Pisces.
- (3) Each planet is also located in a particular house in the chart. These are indicated by the twelve sections of a birth chart.

Your birth chart is therefore a unique blueprint of your personality, every one is different. When you are born, the birth chart represents a set of potentials, it describes the 'form' of your personality and the contents must be added through the experiences of life.

Life Destiny Interpretation

Your birth chart shows the exact positions of the planets at your time of birth. It also tells you the sign of the Zodiac that was rising at your time of birth, known as your 'ascendant'. How the planetary positions of your birth chart relate to each other are interpreted on the following pages outlining your potential development. The interpretation begins with Elements and Modalities of your horoscope.

Element Emphasis

Earth Element strong - Johnny's dependability

You are the essence of common sense and good planning. You prefer to deal with the present moment, the here and now and are more liable to react needing external stimulus to get you going. Stability is your strength you can be counted on if things get out of hand. Very industrious, you can produce things of substance, from children to company reports. You tend to be conventional, unworried by ethical matters, or even intolerant.

Water Element weak - Johnny's emotions

You tend to be out of touch with your emotional, feeling side. Any emotional reaction, such as crying or bad temper, you see as a flaw and is to be avoided when possible. While you may be cool, detached, practical, wilful and impartial, you find it very difficult to relate to others in a sympathetic and responsive way. In times of crisis or emotional stress, your lack of sentimentality can be your greatest asset.

Modality Emphasis

Cardinal Modality weak - Johnny's capabilities

You will never be known as a forceful leader and you probably shun such positions. Do not feel badly about this, though, because you are the one who can be relied on either to keep things stable when times are rough or to keep up with the changing tide when needed. You prefer the tried and tested way and would just as soon leave the ground-breaking path to others.

The Ascendant

The Ascendant is the sign that was rising over the horizon at the time of birth. More than any other chart factor, the sign of the Ascendant, to be accurate, is dependant on both time (it changes by 15 degrees every hour) and place of birth (someone born at the same time on the opposite side of the world will have the opposite sign on the Ascendant or 'rising'). As such, it is the sign that brings us into physical incarnation, and the planet that rules that sign is said to be the ruler of the chart, or our planetary ruler for this lifetime. Hence the sign and house position of the Ascendant's ruler are of particular importance. The ascending sign shows the way in which we approach life and the world in general. It can be related to what some psychologists call the persona, the mask we place between our inner selves and the world. As such it shows the way in which, we are perceived by others, at least their first impressions of us. The Ascendant represents the manner in which we must express ourselves in order to feel secure, and also the filter through which we perceive life and its challenges. It is the cusp of the first house, the house associated with our personal identity and self expression and represents the kind of energy and types of activities that we need to enliven us physically.

Leo Ascendant

With the Fixed Fire sign Leo rising at your time of birth you aim to make an impression on everyone you meet. You have a need to be known as a creative and self-motivated person, and to develop a sense of your own power and worth. You need to be active in some kind of creative or self-expressive pursuit in order to feel enlivened, but your pride may often prevent you from admitting your mistakes to anyone but yourself, or from changing a course of action even when it becomes plain that you are on the wrong track, you do not like to be proved wrong. You can be warm and generous, not slow to give to those who need your help, but there may be a tendency to expect something in return, you will be happier and more content with yourself when you can learn to give without expecting to receive.

The ruler of Leo is the Sun, as the ruler of your ascendant, this planet is of particular importance in your chart.

Ascendant Quinqux Moon

The Quinqux between the Moon and your Ascendant indicates that you are emotionally sensitive to external influences. You will tend to give in to pressures or manipulation by others, feeling that in this way you will at least show that you care, and gain some inner peace. You find it difficult to let go of the feelings of security and emotional well-being that you may have experienced in the past. Regarding the past as 'the good old days', and the present as a time of difficulty and dissatisfaction, will cause some problems in your domestic and/or emotional life. You need to learn to live in the here and now, and that you can stand up for your own needs and be caring at the same time.

Ascendant Trine Jupiter

The Trine between Jupiter and your Ascendant gives you an optimistic outlook on life. You are confident in your own creative talents, perhaps a little over-confident, and you seek to achieve something positive with your life. Not content with standing still or remaining in a comfortable rut, you are open to expanding your range of experiences, to meet new people, see new places, consider new ideas. You often construct ambitious plans and large scale schemes which rarely even get off the ground.

The problem with this aspect is that while you desire to expand your horizons, you tend to sit back and wait for new experiences to come to you, and although you have ambitious plans, you want to achieve them with the minimum of effort on your part, so they are never actually achieved. You need to develop some self discipline and self motivation before you can achieve what you desire; this may come from other aspects in your chart.

Ascendant Square Neptune

With the Square between Neptune and your Ascendant you are extremely sensitive to criticism, which makes you miss opportunities to advance yourself since you are afraid of failure. This aspect inclines you to daydream about your potentials more than actively seeking to realise them. Perhaps communication with your parents was unclear or confused in some way, you did not get the support you needed in choosing a career and you still find it difficult to know just what it is you want out of life. As a result you will tend to spread yourself too thinly and become involved in diverse activities, or take on more than you can efficiently handle. You will need to focus on specific fields if you are to make the most of your talents.



The Sun

In the solar system the Sun is the focal point around which all the other planets revolve, bound by its gravitational force. Similarly, in the birth chart the Sun represents the "centre" of our personality, or the core of our being, around which all the other psychological drives and needs, symbolised by the planets, revolve.

Just as, in the solar system, the Sun is the source of light and life generating energy, so the Sun represents the source of consciousness and life within us all. It is our will to be and our sense of individuality. The birth chart, however, represents the solar system as seen from the earth, not the Sun. Most of us are not centred in our Sun, but in our earthbound, or sense-bound ego. For most of us then, the Sun represents our 'Higher Self' or Spirit. It is the immortal spark of the universal spirit which is uniquely ourselves, as opposed to our transient and mortal ego centred personality. The Sun is therefore what we are striving to become.

The sign position of and aspects to the Sun, as seen from the earth, show how this radiant inner self works through the medium of our ego centred personality. It is the fundamental tone of our being, and as such is the most important placement in the chart.



Sun in Gemini

With the Sun in the mutable air sign of Gemini, you are basically attuned to the level of the mind (symbolised by air). There is restlessness and a need for variety. You have a basic urge to extend yourself through a variety of different contacts and relationships. You are usually on the go, and have a natural ability to do two or more things at once. You have a need for constant intellectual stimulation, and welcome the opportunity to express your opinions, which you can do very well on a number of different subjects. The versatility and adaptability of the Sun in Gemini, if taken to extremes, can lead to a superficial knowledge of many subjects, inconsistency, and the tendency to change your tack in midcourse; then back again, then back. You will need to develop the will power to see a particular course of action through to its conclusion.

11th House

The 11th House is naturally associated with the sign of Aquarius and its ruler Uranus.

Having established a career, public position or our social standing in the 10th, in the 11th House we look to the future and the part we can play as members of various groups or societies. The 11th House therefore represents our hopes and wishes, friends and groups. It is in this area of experience that we seek to act as part of a group that is expressing some greater social need or goal. This house in the chart can indicate how we act in group situations and the kinds of groups to which we are attracted.



Sun in 11th House

With the Sun in the 11th house you may find you need a large circle of friends and acquaintances. This need can be extended to various groups and associations that are trying to achieve some sort of social change. Through such groups you will be able to express yourself openly and gain a sense of purpose and direction. However, you will need to suppress the desire to always be the leader of such groups as you may not always be the right person for the job.



Sun Trine Saturn

The Sun in Trine to Saturn indicates that you are able to work towards your goals with persistence, determination and self-discipline. You have ambition, but you do not feel the need to step on others in order to succeed. Because of this, others will be prepared to help you on your way because they won't feel threatened. You are able to handle responsibility and turn difficult situations into creative opportunities.



Moon

In the birth chart, the Moon is second in importance only to the Sun. Unlike the other planets the Moon orbits the earth, and seen from the earth is the same size as the Sun (hence the possibility of total eclipses). The Moon gives off no light of its own, however, but reflects and polarises the light of the Sun.

The Moon represents memories, feelings and instinctive responses that lie just below the level of consciousness. As the Moon orbits the earth, it generates the movements of the tides and governs other natural cycles, such as the menstrual cycle in women. The Moon therefore symbolises the ebb and flow of feeling and emotion (symbolised by water in Astrology), and the feminine principle in nature and in the individual.

The sign position of and aspects to the Moon show how we react instinctively, and what we need to feel comfortable and secure. As children the Moon is the Mother, or at least how we experienced our mother. As we grow older this extends to our relationships with women in general (particularly for men), and our instinctive or conditioned responses to the world in general; based on the often unconscious memories of this early nurturing experience (or lack of it).

When the time of birth is not known the exact position of the Moon may be different to that shown in your Midday birth chart. You can experiment with alternative birth times to see if the Moon's sign changes on the day you were born and read the different interpretations for each Moon sign.



Moon in Capricorn

With the Moon in the cardinal earth sign of Capricorn, your instinctive way of behaving may be influenced by a deep need for something that is secure and permanent in your home and emotional life, and may see the way to this as the attainment of a conventional and rather rigid home life. This may be the result of a lack of such material and emotional security in your early home life, or the result of values inherited from your parents. Although greatly concerned with your own emotional needs, you can display a degree of coldness when it comes to the emotions of others, and can place heavy stress on their duties and responsibilities. You may need to understand that you will only feel secure and happy with yourself when what you have has been gained by your own efforts, and not something others have a duty to provide.

6th House

The 6th House is naturally associated with the sign of Virgo and its ruler Mercury.

Having expressed our creativity in the 5th, the 6th House is where we are confronted with the need to adjust to, and learn from, the demands of the material world. This is the House associated with work and service. The 6th House indicates the nature of, and our attitude toward, our working environment and our relations with co-workers, employees or bosses. It is also connected with health and the interaction of mind and body to maintain the efficient (or inefficient) working of our physical bodies.



Moon in 6th House

With the Moon in the 6th House, your emotions can be quite secretive and often inaccessible to others. When someone you do not really trust or know gets too close, up go the barricades. It takes quite some time for those barricades to be broken down, for an acquaintance to become a friend.

There is also a strong connection between your emotions and your physical health. When you are feeling emotionally low, this could lead to physical illness, whereas a sense of emotional happiness will bring about a sense of physical well-being.

At work, the way you feel about colleagues or bosses may go through phases, according to your fluctuating moods. They will certainly know about it when you have that Monday morning mood.



Moon Square Jupiter

Jupiter and the Moon in a Square aspect indicate that your emotions can occasionally be rather fiery and unstable. There seems to be a conflict between your need for emotional support and sharing, and a need for independence. The end result being that you often swing between feelings of dependence and independence, enthusiasm and depression. At times you may also have some difficulty in balancing your personal responsibilities with your professional ambitions, causing conflict within yourself and with those closest to you.

Your sympathy and understanding makes you generous towards others, but you may also occasionally be overly extravagant, spending money that you do not have, or buying on credit in anticipation of what is to come. In order to avoid getting into difficulties, you need to apply strict financial controls to yourself, or at the very least, try to follow a sensible budget.



Moon Sextile Neptune

The Sextile between the Moon and Neptune stimulates your imagination and psychic sensitivity. You are sensitive to the vibrations and emotions in the atmosphere around you. However, your imagination can get carried away at times.



Moon Trine Pluto

The Moon in a Trine aspect to Pluto strengthens and deepens your emotional nature. You will generally be able to weather any storm with the knowledge that a crisis is often necessary to shake you out of a rut, and that you will emerge from it with a greater inner strength and understanding.



Mercury

Mercury is the closest planet to the Sun. Along with Venus it is one of the inferior planets, that is, its orbit lies within the earth's orbit.

In mythology, Mercury is the messenger of the gods. In the birth chart, Mercury represents the urge to communicate with and exchange information with others. In the mind, it represents our rational thought processes, or the ability to analyse and reach logical conclusions. In the body, it is the nervous system, which co-ordinates and unifies all the different bodily functions into an organised whole. Mercury can be said to represent electricity in the form of information. Mercury therefore rules all forms of communication and exchange of information, and the ability to organise facts into a consistent view of the world.

The sign position of and aspects to Mercury in the chart show how one thinks and communicates, that is, the way in which our thoughts are expressed, and the way in which we receive such information from the world around us.



Mercury in Taurus

With Mercury in the fixed earth sign of Taurus, your mind is practical and down to earth. Taurus brings stability your thoughts, giving you the ability to concentrate for long periods of time. You will not make snap decisions, needing time to assimilate all the facts and arrive at a sensible and usually practical conclusion. This same tendency may make you, slow to appreciate other people's opinions, and have a lack of flexibility in your outlook, as a result of your stubbornness and fixed opinions.

Mercury in this sign can bring a degree of dependability to any more restless tendencies that may be shown in your chart.

10th House

The 10th house is naturally connected with the sign of Capricorn and its ruler Saturn.

The beginning, or cusp, of the 10th House is called the Midheaven. This is the degree of the ecliptic that was at the highest point in the sky at the time and place of birth. The Midheaven and the 10th house therefore represents our ambitions, what we aim for and hope to achieve in the world. In this House we attempt to bring the ideals and aspirations of the 9th to practical realisation. This results in a career or a particular position in the social order. The 10th is also connected with our relations with authority figures in general, and with the way we experienced our parents in particular.



Mercury in 10th House

Mercury, the planet of communication is in the House of ambitions and career, directing much of your mental energy and intellect towards the achievement of a position of responsibility and authority.

However, your impatience and eagerness to pursue a particular career may lead to many false starts and wrong turns before you finally decide what it is you really want to do, but you will learn a great deal about yourself in the process.

You have a need to be seen as intelligent and will probably settle in a career that enables you to express the need to communicate. You would therefore do well in all areas concerned with communication, the media, journalism, teaching, writing and transport.



Mercury Conjunct Venus

Mercury and Venus, the planets of communication and relationship, were in Conjunction at your time of birth. You will therefore generally be fair and balanced in your thinking. When you express your opinions or have to make a decision about some issue, you will more often than not take care to examine all sides and reach an impartial decision. You do not really like to offend anyone, not even people you disagree with.

Possessing a natural charm, you would make a good public speaker, and should also get much pleasure from writing and the arts. You have a natural ability to turn your ideas into money, and as others generally respect your abilities, you usually have no trouble getting financial backing.



Mercury Square Mars

The Square between Mercury and Mars indicates that you are generally able to express yourself with a great deal of energy, but that you do not always think things out carefully or consider all of the facts before you voice your opinion.

You can also occasionally have an explosive temper, and when upset your criticisms or verbal attacks can be cutting and hurtful. Perhaps you had to learn early in life to defend yourself verbally, or put your opinions across in a forceful or aggressive manner in order to be heard. Whatever the case, the end result is that in adulthood you will tend to regard challenges to your opinions and ideas as a direct attack on yourself, and react accordingly.

In your home or professional life particularly you are not afraid to take a stand for what you believe, although at times if you looked at things more objectively, you may be able to see that you could be acting rather unreasonably.



Mercury Square Saturn

Mercury Square to Saturn could be a difficult aspect to handle. It tends to make you look on the gloomy side of things, to think more about obstacles and potential difficulties than about opportunities and exploration.

Nevertheless, your caution and thoroughness in intellectual matters will benefit you well. Indeed, your tendency to look for problems before they arise means that you usually have the solution already to hand when it is needed.

Mercury Square Uranus

The Square between Mercury and Uranus indicates a high level of nervous tension. Uranus "electrifies" whatever it contacts in the chart, and with Mercury it will be the nervous system and intellect that benefits from this powerful Uranian energy. Your mind is stimulated by visions of the future, open to new ideas and new ways of thinking.

You generally do not allow yourself to get into an intellectual rut. You may occasionally find it difficult, however, to control your mind and find a state of inner peace as your thoughts are always racing ahead of you. Occasionally, however, you may be on a "short fuse", reacting too quickly to other people's opinions before you have fully considered what they have said.

You can learn quickly, your intuition is strong and you have many original and inventive ideas, but to make the most of your powerful mental energies, you will need to learn to slow down and relax occasionally.

Venus

Venus, like Mercury, lies within the orbit of the earth. If Mercury can be likened to electricity in the form of information, then Venus can be likened to the magnetic field generated by the electric current. One of the meanings of Venus is therefore "personal magnetism".

In mythology Venus is the goddess of love. In the birth chart, Venus represents the social and love urge, and the need for harmony and exchange of feelings and affection with others. Venus is our need to form relationships and our power to attract such relationships. It is also our sense of values, based on what attracts or repels us.

The sign position of any aspect to Venus shows how we express these needs to others and the kind of response we need in order to feel in harmony. If Venus is adversely placed these responses may not always be what we consciously desire but are often necessary in order to force us to recognise some unexpressed part of ourselves.

Venus in Taurus

Venus, the planet of relationships, is in the fixed earth sign of Taurus in your chart. This indicates that you are loyal and security minded in your approach to relationships, and the physical expression of love and affection will be important to you. You may seek permanence in your relationships for the feeling of security and stability that it gives you, and you will be happy to provide for these needs in your partner. You will give the appearance of coolness and reserve, but this masks a deep and passionate feeling nature. You can be strongly but quietly jealous of any situation or person that you feel is a threat to your emotional security.

Venus in 10th House

With Venus in your House of career and reputation, you will probably seek a career that allows you to express your artistic abilities and will prefer harmony and co-operation in your professional life rather than back-stabbing and power struggles. Whatever you want to achieve with your life will have to be done with grace and style.

You need to work with people you like and can get along with and you may form many romantic attachments as a direct result of your career activities, or you may become involved with someone who can help and support you in your career goals.

Venus Square Mars

In your chart, Venus, the planet of love is in a Square aspect to Mars, the planet of aggression. This could cause a conflict between your need to be close to someone and your need for emotional independence. This may also lead to a sense of dissatisfaction with yourself, and irritability with those closest to you since you feel that they're always getting in your way and preventing you from doing what you want to do.

The more placid and charming energy of Venus can cover over the tension for a while, but the more aggressive and demanding energy of Mars will eventually break out and shatter the peace.

A sense of excitement and satisfaction in your love life will be important. If sex becomes dull and routine or you feel that you are no longer appreciated or desired you will find a new relationship that will rekindle the spark of desire.

Venus Square Saturn

The Square between Venus and Saturn indicates some difficulty in the handling of your personal relationships. You may have difficulty in finding a partner who lives up to your rather exacting expectations. Judging the other's faults harshly, you will not allow anyone to get too close until you feel that they're safe and can be trusted. You do not express affection easily, withholding your feelings out of the fear that they will be rejected.

This feeling may result from experiences as a child as one of your parents, possibly your father, may have been indifferent or difficult to get close to. The rejection you felt then has carried through to the present and you will therefore approach present relationships warily. On the other hand, the father may not have been around at all.

The way around this conflict is to establish this missing sense of security by achieving something through your own efforts. When you realise that you do not need the support of anyone to make something of your life, you will feel happier and more secure about yourself.

Venus Square Uranus

Venus, the planet of relationships is in a Square aspect to the more independent planet Uranus. At times you may therefore experience some difficulty, and sudden changes or breaks in your relationships. If people try to get too close too quickly, you will rapidly back off.

You also probably have little regard for traditional forms of marriage since this would considerably reduce your freedom to do what you want, a freedom you do not easily relinquish. Any form of jealousy and possessiveness particularly horrifies you.

Even if you are involved in a serious relationship, or married, you will still demand a great deal of freedom and independence for yourself. You may try to suppress these needs for a while out of respect for the other person's feelings or wishes, but if you do so for too long, the tensions will build up until your need for freedom erupts to the surface.



Mars

Mars is the first planet in the series out from the Sun that is outside the orbit of the earth. As the first superior planet, Mars represents energy directed outward from the self into the world. It is the energy to initiate action and the ability to meet challenges and overcome obstacles. In mythology, Mars is the god of war. In the birth chart, Mars is the self assertive and aggressive urge, the sex drive and the need to achieve our desires. Positively, Mars is expressed as courage, initiative, and the will-power to pursue our goals. Negatively expressed, Mars is impatience, violence and the use of force or threats.

The sign position of and aspects to Mars in the chart show how we assert ourselves and express our desires. Mars is traditionally a masculine planet, and therefore represents the expression of the male ego. In a woman's chart, the energy of Mars is often repressed by social and family conditioning, and indicates how she will experience the male ego through the men around her, whether positively or negatively expressed. It is, however, becoming increasingly possible for women to break away from traditional passive roles, and express their own Martian drives, but this is often not completely successful until after the age of about 30.



Mars in Virgo

With Mars in the mutable earth sign of Virgo you will put a great deal of energy into managing your practical and material affairs. No matter how tight money is, you will somehow always manage to pay your bills and provide the basic necessities of life. You may be over critical both of yourself and others, with a tendency to constantly question motives, and the need to understand the whys and wherefores of everything you do, particularly in the area of your sex life. If this is not taken to inhibiting extremes you can gain great insight into the hidden or unconscious motives and needs, both your own and those of others. You should avoid a tendency to worry or feel guilty when the actions of others drive you into expressing your anger or aggression.

1st House

The 1st House is naturally associated with Aries and its ruling planet Mars.

The ascendant is the cusp of the 1st House. This House represents the area of life concerned with our sense of self-identity. Signs and planets in this House reflect both who we are and how we meet life. It represents our personal identity, and the need to be a separate and distinct person. the physical body is the material expression of our self identity, and its strengths and weaknesses are indicated by this House. Another way of viewing the 1st House is as the lens through which we perceive life, and which colours our view of existence.



Mars in 1st House

With Mars in the 1st House of your chart you will have plenty of energy, and will be able to assert yourself directly and if necessary, rather forcefully. Restrictions on your personal freedom will rarely be tolerated. You are certainly not the type to sit quietly in a corner, you need to let everybody know that you are around!



Mars Conjunct Uranus

Mars in Conjunction with rebellious Uranus makes a pretty dynamic combination. You are fiercely independent, impulsive and self-motivated and when you know what you want, you will go for it with a tireless energy and determination that will find a way around all obstacles, or crash straight through them! Your emotions can explode at a moment's notice.

You are not very good at taking advice as, more often than not, you have to do things your way or not at all. Others may therefore occasionally regard you as arrogant and reckless, but you need excitement and stimulation, and if your life becomes too routine and boring you are likely to stir things up just for the hell of it.

Your physical desires are strong, and you don't need emotional closeness or involvement in order to satisfy these desires.

You also don't like any restrictions placed on your actions, preferring to be free to act on your own initiative, and in any way you choose. Therefore your insistence on this right will probably end up causing you some conflict with others during your life.

This combination makes your life a constant fight for freedom and independence on one level or another but if you can use this tremendous energy to fight for the freedom and independence of others who, for some reason, cannot fight for themselves, you will be expressing this aspect in its purest form.



Mars Conjunct Pluto

The Conjunction between Mars and Pluto indicates that you can be determined and persistent. When you decide that you want something, there is generally no stopping you until you get it, although your motives may often be simply to prove to yourself and others that you can get your own way.

You assert yourself with an intensity and power that some admire, and some find threatening. As a result you are usually able to get your own way, and although whilst you have a powerful need to assert your own desires, you also have tremendous self-control, able to hold yourself back until the right moment before making your move. Nevertheless, you have very little tolerance for anything and anyone who tries to stand in your way.



Jupiter

The planets up to and including Mars have been concerned with the establishment of ourselves as individuals, and with the satisfaction of our own needs and desires. The planets beyond Mars connect us with a larger order.

As the largest planet in the solar system, Jupiter represents expansion and growth. It is the urge to grow beyond our individual limitations and the need to feel part of a larger order, whether this be a particular religion, philosophy or social system. Jupiter, the king of the gods, traditionally bestows faith, optimism and the ability to expand and prosper. It is the planet that promotes personal growth, gives us confidence in ourselves and trust in a higher power or greater plan. Negatively, Jupiter can manifest as overconfidence, irresponsibility and the tendency to over-extend ourselves or promise too much.

The sign position of and aspects to Jupiter in the chart show what kinds of experiences and types of activity create an inner faith and optimism, and the sense of being connected to the larger scheme of things.

Jupiter in Aries

The planet Jupiter represents the principle of expansion and growth, it is the optimistic urge to broaden our horizons both mentally and materially. In the cardinal fire sign of Aries you will need to maintain a high level of enterprise, coupled with a sense of self esteem, in order to make the most of opportunities that may come your way. This will be easy enough when things are going well, at such times you will feel confident and determined, even over confident and over zealous, but when things go wrong your confidence may crash and your determination collapse, or you will react with anger. You need to feel that you play a part in the greater scheme of things to maintain your self confidence and sense of identity.

You are independent and you need the freedom to pursue your own goals. You feel that you are establishing your own identity when you are chasing distant horizons, and you do not like to be obstructed on the journey.

9th House

The 9th House is naturally associated with the sign of Sagittarius and its ruler Jupiter.

After the often painful experiences in the 8th, in the 9th House we seek to understand the meaning of our experiences and our connections to the greater whole. This House represents our search for meaning through philosophy and religion. In this area of life we also seek to expand our knowledge and awareness through travel and higher education. Hence this House is also connected with all forms of higher education, travel to foreign lands, the law, religion and the use of the higher or more intuitive mental faculties.

Jupiter in 9th House

Jupiter is in the 9th House of your chart, the area of experience connected with travel and higher education, religion and philosophy. It is through these activities that you can best grow beyond your present mental and physical limitations and find faith and meaning in life.

Indeed, this is a good placing for long distance travel, but this will be most beneficial if undertaken as a learning experience, for the purpose of gaining greater understanding and knowledge. In these matters foreign people should be of great benefit to you.

Jupiter Quinquax Neptune

With the Quinquax between Jupiter and Neptune, you have high ideals, but you may lack the discipline required to make these ideals a reality in your own life. Understanding and sympathetic to others, you may at times unknowingly allow others to take advantage of your good nature.

If you can discipline your imaginative mind, perhaps through meditation or self-analysis, you could gain a great deal more understanding about yourself.

Saturn

Saturn is the last planet in the solar system that can be seen with the naked eye from the earth. As such, together with the fact that it is bounded by a series of rings, Saturn represents the boundaries of the individual.

After the limitless expansion of Jupiter, Saturn in the birth chart represents boundaries and limitations. It is the principle of structure and form. In the body, it is the skeleton, which gives the body its structure, and the skin, which is the boundary to the outside world. In the mind, it is the structure of our ego and our sense of self which we seek to preserve from the impact of changes from within and from the outside world. Saturn gives us the ability to endure setbacks and work with discipline and patience toward well defined aims. It is the need for social approval through some kind of tangible achievement. Whereas Jupiter brings rewards and opportunities through what we might call good luck, Saturn brings rewards and opportunities through hard work, limitation and self discipline.

The sign position of and aspects to Saturn show how we seek to establish ourselves as individuals and find our place in the social system of which we are a part. Any form or structure, however, when placed in the light of the Sun tends to cast a shadow. The position of Saturn in the chart therefore, shows where we find our "shadow". It is here that we meet with our greatest sense of inadequacy, lack of faith and inhibitions. Saturn shows where we are most fearful, and hence most rigid; but if these fears can be met and overcome it is the source of our greatest strength and a solid foundation from which to meet the world.

Saturn in Aquarius

With Saturn in the fixed air sign of Aquarius, it is important that you have objectives in life, and once determined they are likely to be adhered to. Saturn in an air sign indicates the ability to give structure and form to your thoughts, to bring the ideals that you hold from the realm of the mind to practical reality. On the other hand, you may feel uncertain and insecure about your intellectual capacity. There is an innate need to belong to some kind of group that gives structure and security to your life. You may avoid this need, however, out of fear of belonging, or self consciousness in group situations. It is both your deepest need and your deepest fear. Even if you overcome this fear, you may still be something of an outsider, unsure of your acceptance by the rest of the group. You have, however, the ability to give practical application to group objectives.

7th House

The 7th House is naturally associated with the sign of Libra and its ruler Venus.

This House represents the field of relationships. If the 1st House is the House of self, then the 7th is the House of others. This House indicates how we express ourselves in our relationships and what qualities we seek in others. In particular it represents the marriage partner, at least the first major relationship with that kind of commitment. In general it represents the area of social contact and the need for relationships of various kinds, and can be extended to our dealings with the general public.



Saturn in 7th House

Saturn in the 7th House of your chart implies a potential difficulty in dealing with relationships. This may be the result of a difficult relationship with your father, perhaps he was not around when you needed him, or unable to relate to you in the way that you need.

You may therefore at times resist becoming too involved with others out of a fear of rejection. You may also feel that you do not really want to become too dependent on another person, and so put off marriage or a more permanent relationship until later in life. On the other hand, the same inner fears may lead you into a long relationship at a very early age, thus missing the period of change and experimentation that most young people go through.



Uranus

Uranus is the first of the trans-Saturnian planets. It cannot be seen with the naked eye and was discovered in 1781 during the period of the American and French revolutions. Its discovery was made possible by the invention of the telescope, a development that has led to radical changes in our knowledge of the universe and our place in it.

In the birth chart then, Uranus represents the force for revolutionary change, the breaking from tradition, and inventiveness and experimentation. As one of the three planets that cannot be seen with the unaided eye, Uranus represents a force over which we have little or no conscious control. On an individual level, Uranus indicates our degree of independence and demand for personal freedom. If well placed it gives us originality and an ability to attune to truth that goes beyond the logic of Mercury. If we refuse to express the energy of Uranus within us, preferring to cling to the traditions and limitations of Saturn, then Uranus may manifest as disruptions and sudden changes in our immediate environment, sometimes disrupting our lives completely and forcing us to make needed changes. If the energy of Uranus is expressed negatively, it can lead to wilfulness, impatience and needless rebellion, the rebel without a cause.

The position of Uranus in the chart shows where we most feel the need for freedom and independence and the need to experiment with new ideas and ways of living. Conversely, it is the area where we can cause the most disruption and needless change.



Uranus in Virgo

You are not likely to stay in a job out of a sense of duty or tolerate work that has become routine and boring. Your work needs to allow you scope for originality, inventiveness and movement. You will want to do things your own way and will dislike being bound by other people's rules and regulations. This could therefore lead to many disruptions and changes in your career. Beware being over critical. Unusual ideas about food may also lead to strange eating habits. There is also a slight danger of stress related illnesses and being more accident prone than most.

**Uranus in 1st House**

With Uranus in the 1st House of your chart you will not be satisfied in fulfilling the traditional role imposed on you by society and culture. You will need to make your own way in life, to be different from the norm in some way, if you are not you are likely to feel frustrated and bored. You have difficulty in adhering to conventional standards of conduct, and may even enjoy shocking others.

The have a kind of electric aura that others may find attractive or difficult to handle. You do not like to be taken for granted, you need to be respected for your own originality and uniqueness, to be seen as an individual with the freedom to make your own choices and be yourself, although it may take you some time to gain a clear understanding of who you are and what you really want from life.

**Neptune**

After Uranus comes Neptune, the god of the sea. Whereas Uranus is the urge for individual freedom and independence, Neptune is the urge to escape from our normal sense-bound state of consciousness, and experience our unity with a different level of reality.

In the birth chart, Neptune represents our higher ideals and our ability to attune to realities that lie beyond those perceived by the senses. It is the realm of dreams and imagination and our sense of being part of a whole which is greater than ourselves, the awareness of a spiritual dimension to existence. Neptune represents the urge to transcend our normal state of consciousness through meditation and mystical experience, music, dreams and flights of the imagination, or through drugs (including alcohol) which afford us a temporary escape from the mundane grind of living. Neptune can be expressed as high ideals, altruism and spiritual values, or as self destructive escapism and evasion of responsibilities. For most of us it is a mixture of both.

The position of Neptune in the chart shows where and how we seek to express these needs, and in what areas of our lives we tend to seek an often impossible ideal.

**Neptune in Scorpio**

Born between 1957-1970 you are part of a permissive generation whose experimentation with sex and drugs invaded everyday life and eroded many traditional family values. This was also the most prominent time of the Cold War, a time of spies and secret surveillance.

4th House

The 4th House is naturally associated with the sign of Cancer and its ruling planet, the Moon.

In the 3rd House we are concerned with communicating with our immediate environment, this leads, in the 4th, to the need to establish a private domain to which we can retreat from the world.

The 4th House represents our roots, both psychological and material. In the psychological sense it is our early family and cultural conditioning, which gives us a sense of belonging, and produces deep inner feelings and habit patterns. The 4th House together with the opposite House, the 10th, is connected with our experience of our parents. In the material sense it is our own home, from which we go out to meet the world and to which we can retreat to rest and recuperate. As well as representing our early home environment, this House is also connected with the conditions surrounding us during the second half of life.

**Neptune in 4th House**

The position of Neptune in the chart shows where we are most idealistic, or where a great deal of self sacrifice may be necessary. With Neptune in your 4th House you may be rather idealistic about your early home life, regarding that time as the "good old days" when everything in the garden was rosy. On the other hand, unusual and uncertain conditions in your home, or with your parents, may have resulted in the need for considerable self-sacrifice as a child. It may be that one or both of your parents were absent, or too involved in helping others to give you the love and attention that you needed, this placing is also often found in the charts of people who's parents had a drug or alcohol problem.

In any event, you will have a deep yearning to find some kind of "spiritual home", where you can feel that you really belong. You may open up your own home to people and groups who are seeking some deeper meaning in their own life, or you may drift from one home to another with some deep seated sense of dissatisfaction making it difficult for you to settle down in one place. Confused and uncertain conditions may arise in your present home life as a result of excessive idealism in this area.

**Neptune Sextile Pluto**

This aspect between the two outermost planets first occurred in 1942 and will remain in effect for the next hundred years, although the sign positions of the planets will change, so everyone born during this time will have it in their charts. This contact will therefore affect everyone for the next hundred years and represents changes taking place in the world's collective psyche. The keynote of this entire period will be the complete transformation of our existing scientific, religious and political belief systems.

**Pluto**

Pluto is the outermost planet in the solar system and therefore the slowest moving. At certain times however, due to the high eccentricity of its orbit, it comes closer to the earth than Neptune. This was so from 1984 -1999. At that same time it passed through Scorpio, the sign that it rules. This was a very critical period in world history, since Pluto represents powerful forces of death and destruction or change and transformation, which were at their strongest. This could have lead to destruction through nuclear war or our pollution and exploitation of our planet or to the death of the current political and economical systems and the birth of new political and economic systems, together with a transformation in international relations as well as our relationship to our planet. When Pluto left Scorpio in 1999 all these issues were much altered.

In the individual birth chart, Pluto represents the urge for power and control either over ourselves or others. It is the need to penetrate beneath the surface of experience, to reveal hidden motivations and repressed desires. The position of Pluto in the chart indicates our capacity for self-regeneration or rebirth and our attitude towards beginnings and endings and birth and death, either actual or symbolic. Pluto can be expressed as the acceptance of our need for complete transformation in some area of our life, and the courage to face our deepest compulsions and hang-ups. Or, it can be expressed as the wilful manipulation of others, ruthlessness and an infatuation with power.



Pluto in Virgo

Pluto was in Virgo between 1957-1971. When you were born your generation experienced a time of powerful political forces such as trade unions, unparalleled changes within the health and welfare system, a time of tremendous changes within many work environments due to computers and automation. New developments in birth control led to greater sexual freedom, and experimentation with psychedelic drugs revealed previously unknown levels of consciousness.



Pluto in 1st House

Pluto in your 1st House, indicates that you have a powerful need to in some way re-mould your character at certain points in your life. Pluto represents the force of change and transformation, with this planet in the House of the personal self you will periodically need to clear your life of certain structures that you feel are limiting your growth, such as a bad relationship or job. If you do not feel or express the energy of Pluto within yourself, you may unconsciously act in ways that provoke someone else into doing the job for you, so the other person breaks up the relationship, or your boss gives you the sack. In these cases you will see this as a crisis, until you are able to admit that this was what you needed, and secretly desired.

You may have a deep distrust of life, early experiences may have made you feel that there are destructive forces in the world that are out to get you, feeling that life can be ruthless, you may express a certain degree of ruthlessness in getting what you want. Fear of your own mortality arises from a sense of the inevitability of transformation and death. Death can occur in many forms, from the death of an old way of life, an old way of thinking, to actual physical death, but all are actually a prelude to a new birth or new beginning.



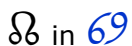
The Midheaven

Represents your ambitions and potential for achievement.



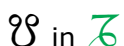
Midheaven in Taurus

North Node in Cancer











